

Section 1011 Eligibility Check List

Providers must supply CMS with acceptable evidence that the patients served are undocumented immigrants to qualify for payment under Section 1011 of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003. Providers are not required to ask immigration status; however, if they do not do so, then alternative proof must be supplied under the “Missing and Faulty” information section below.

REQUESTS FOR DOUMENTATATION SHOULD NOT DELAY SCREENING AND STABILIZATION SERVICES REQUIRED UNDER EMTALA.

If the patient is willing to self-attest, no other information is required.

- Passport, Visa, or Border crossing card
 - Foreign driver’s license
 - Foreign birth certificate
 - Foreign voting card
 - Foreign bank card
 - Foreign Address
 - Other _____
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Missing or faulty information may also be used to demonstrate claims eligibility. At least one of the first criteria must be met and at least two of the second criteria must be met.

- Foreign Born
- Invalid Social Security number
- Invalid Medicaid card

AND

- Lack of Social Security number
- Lack of a U.S. Driver’s License/State ID card
- Lack of health insurance
- Lack of a valid address
