The emphasis of this grant program is on service delivery through collaboration.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Grantee must have 2 additional partners • Headquarters must be rural public or rural nonprofit private entity and must be located in a rural county or in a rural census tract of an urban county • Exceptions to this are 330(g) Migrant Health Clinics who exclusively provide services to migrant and seasonal farmworkers in rural areas or a Federally recognized Native American Tribal Government providing all of the proposed services on Federally-recognized Tribal land • Non-profit status at time of application • Community being served must be involved in the development and ongoing operations of the program, to appropriately address the needs of the population 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assuming that there will be level funding for FY 2009, the Office plans to fund approximately 90 Outreach grantees with a start date of May 1, 2009. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HRSA is <i>requiring</i> applicants for this funding opportunity to apply electronically through Grants.gov. • All applicants <i>must</i> submit in this manner unless the applicant is granted a written exemption from this requirement in advance by the Director of HRSA's Division of Grants Policy. • Applications include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Budget Justification - Staffing Plan - Project Abstract - Program Narrative - Request for Funding Preference 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There is typically an annual announcement and competition for awards; however, for Fiscal Year 2008, there will not be a competitive cycle. • The next competitive announcement is expected for FY 2009 with the guidance being released Summer of 2008. • For more detailed information, please visit the website listed above.
