# Call for Nominations

**AHA Section for Psychiatric and Substance Abuse Services**

*Class of 2007-2009*

**The Nominating Committee of the Section For Psychiatric and Substance Abuse Services is actively soliciting nominations of highly qualified candidates for 3-year terms commencing January 1, 2007.**

## **SECTION PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Psychiatric and Substance Abuse Section is to promote and enhance the understanding of the mental health and substance abuse treatment needs of persons of all ages, and of the issues pertinent to behavioral health care provider organizations. The section seeks to identify priority issues to address and ways to define and focus AHA policy, advocacy, and service efforts on behalf of all members of the behavioral health care field. ## **GOVERNING COUNCIL ROLE**

The section's governing council provides input and participates in the overall policy development process of the AHA. Council members often take an important role in identifying and tracking issues of special interest to the types of organizations and services they represent. They also play a liaison role with other health care and consumer organizations concerned with similar issues.

The term of office is for three years beginning January 1, 2007 and expiring on December 31, 2009. Governing council members attend two-to-three, 2-day meetings each year in various geographic locations, with conference calls scheduled as necessary. AHA pays the expenses of members of the governing council for expenses they incur related to council meetings.

## **CRITERIA/QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY:**

Candidates for nomination should hold senior level positions (i.e., presidents, vice presidents, CEOs, COOs, department heads, medical directors, trustees, nurse executives) in hospitals or networks, which are members of the American Hospital Association. Candidates should also

- ✓ Have responsibility for services in the behavioral health care continuum, which may include adult, child and adolescent, and/or geriatric psychiatric or addiction treatment programs,

- ✓ Demonstrate commitment to AHA's vision of integrated delivery systems, for example, through the establishment of cooperative and collaborative relationships with other institutions and organizations in their community to enhance health care to residents
- ✓ Have the support of their hospital/system CEO, if applicable,

Please keep in mind as you develop your recommendations that the AHA Board of Trustees has made a strong commitment to increasing diversity in governance positions. Please make every effort to include qualified women and minorities in your recommendations. Candidates from all regions and of all responsibilities will be considered; however we are also seeking individuals with the following roles and responsibilities:

- CEO of a general hospital with a strong psychiatric or addiction treatment program.
- Administrator or clinician with a strong addiction treatment program or dual diagnosis program.
- Department Head or Medical Director of a quality mental health or substance abuse treatment program.
- CEO of a freestanding psychiatric hospital
- Executive Director/Commanding Officer of a Veterans or Federal Hospital.

Additionally, we are especially seeking highly qualified candidates to fill upcoming positions in AHA regions, 2, 3, 6, 7 and 8; however, candidates from all regions will be considered. A list of AHA regions is included for your reference.


