Currently, there are **37 states** using federal exchanges to offer health insurance plans to Americans. **In 2015**, more than **8.8 million Americans** have signed up for health care using federal exchanges, of whom **87% receive subsidies**.

The United States Supreme Court will rule by June in the *King v. Burwell* case, which will determine whether subsidies will continue to be available through federal exchanges.

If the ruling finds federal exchanges are ineligible for subsidies,
