Florida is one of 37 states using Federal Exchanges to offer health insurance plans to Floridians. In 2015, more than **8.8 million Americans** have signed up for health care using Federal Exchanges, of whom 87% receive subsidies.

The United States Supreme Court will rule by June in the King v. Burwell case, which will determine whether subsidies will continue to be available through Federal Exchange states like Florida.
