

HEALTH INSURANCE IS IN JEOPARDY IN FLORIDA



KING V. BURWELL | IMPACT ON FLORIDA

Florida is one of 37 states using Federal Exchanges to offer health insurance plans to **Floridians**. In 2015, more than **8.8 million Americans** have signed up for health care using Federal Exchanges, of whom **87% receive subsidies**.

The United States Supreme Court will rule by June in the *King v. Burwell* case, which will determine whether subsidies will continue to be available through Federal Exchange states like **Florida**.
