Dr. Mirnova Ceïde is an Assistant Professor of Geriatric Psychiatry and Geriatric Medicine at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine/Montefiore Medical Center and the Assistant Program Director of the Geriatric Psychiatry Fellowship. She completed her Adult Psychiatry Training at John Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, MD. She went on to complete a HRSA fellowship at SUNY Downstate in Geriatric Psychiatry where she also participated in health disparities research at the Brooklyn Health Disparities Center.

She joined the Geriatric Psychiatry Division at Montefiore Medical Center in 2013 where she has multiple consultative roles in integrated behavioral health programs across the Montefiore Network including the Geriatric Psychiatrist for Montefiore Home Care, and the Center for the Aging. She received a KL2 Career Development Award in 2017 to study apathy and dementia and is pursuing a Master's in Science. She has presented at national and international meetings on the topics of health disparities and models of psychiatric integration in health care.
