

## Montefiore Health System

Montefiore Health System consists of eleven hospitals, 4 of which are part of the academic medical center, comprising 3,236 beds, including a 132-bed children's hospital and a rehabilitation hospital; a freestanding emergency department; a primary and specialty care network of more than 180 locations, including 16 mental health and substance abuse treatment clinics, across Westchester County, the lower Hudson Valley and the Bronx; a 150-bed extended care facility; the Montefiore School of Nursing; two home health agencies; 23 school health clinics; a provider network of nearly 5,000 employed and community-based private practice physicians and allied clinicians; and the Albert Einstein College of Medicine.

Its hospitals discharge more than 140,000 patients a year; its emergency departments treat almost 600,000 people each year and its ambulatory sites record 5.3 million visits annually. CMO, Montefiore Care Management, provides care coordination and disease management services for nearly 360,000 and members of Medicare, Medicaid and commercial health plans and beneficiaries of government healthcare programs, including a Next Generation Accountable Care Organization, a Medicaid Health Home and a managed long term care plan, under a variety of value-based contracts.
