

How Patient Care Benefits from Enhancing Safety

Research has found that unhealthy workplace conditions deteriorate nurse mental health and compromise nurses' ability to deliver effective care to patients and their families.

Key Questions:

- Does your staff feel safe at work?
- Can the health care workforce afford NOT to invest in safety?
- How could the workforce and quality of care improve in your organization through enhanced safety measures?

19% of Nurses who changed or left their roles cited safety as a factor.
37% said they consider leaving the profession² entirely.
