

Protect Access to Care:

Reject cuts to the Medicaid program and premium hikes on working families.

If Congress cuts Medicaid, hospitals would see significant negative impacts that vary by policy:

Per Capita Caps for All Medicaid Population	-\$47.6B	-\$468.1B
Per Capita Caps for Expansion Population	-\$18.9B	-\$199.9B
Eliminate Enhanced FMAP for Expansion Population	-\$32B	-\$360.6B
Reduce FMAP Statutory Floor to 45%	-\$7.3B	-\$78.4B
Limit Provider Taxes to 5%	-\$3B	-\$32.8B
