



Care Delivery Transformation Framework: A Discussion Guide for Hospital Leaders

Hospitals and health care systems across the United States are transforming care delivery to better meet the needs of their patients and communities across their lifespans while bolstering long-term financial sustainability. The American Hospital Association's [Care Delivery Transformation Framework](#) offers curated resources to help hospitals develop innovative improvement strategies.

This discussion guide can help hospital leaders foster conversations with their teams and identify opportunities to transform care delivery. Use the guide to identify priority tactics and design an action plan to address a specific issue using an integrated approach.

How to Use This Discussion Guide

Assemble your team. Make sure that you have stakeholders present from across your organization. It is important to hear perspectives from your clinicians, quality improvement leaders, lay health care providers, patients, community partners and health care administrators.

Create time and space for conversation. These discussion questions may elicit in-depth, nuanced conversations, so we recommend convening your team in a time and place where everyone can devote their attention to the issues.

Space out your conversations. You do not need to complete this discussion guide in one sitting. Divide up the discussion topics into manageable blocks of time.

You do not have to have all the answers. This discussion guide asks a lot of questions — you might not have the answers on hand. Ask team members to review questions in advance so they can investigate the data and follow up on outstanding questions.

Give yourself time to reflect. These questions will prepare you to think critically about how your organization is addressing care delivery transformation. It will be important for all team members to bring humility and an open mind to the conversation.

What's next? Use your team discussions as a launching point. Care delivery transformation strategies should be customized to the unique situation of your hospital and community.
