

# What's at Stake:

## Medicaid covers the people you know.



**The majority of Kansas residents with Medicaid coverage are children**

**31%** of children in Kansas are covered by Medicaid



**Medicaid protects access to care for rural communities**

Among Kansas Medicaid beneficiaries, **32%** of children and **11%** of adults live in rural communities



**Medicaid supports access to essential obstetrics care, behavioral health services, and primary care**

**31%** of births in Kansas are covered by Medicaid



**Medicaid provides access to care for low-income seniors**

**87K** seniors in Kansas are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid

**Fact:** Medicaid chronically underpays for services.

Without supplemental payments, Medicaid fee-for-services payments nationally paid **58 cents** for every dollar that hospitals spent caring for Medicaid patients, and Medicaid managed care organizations paid **65 cents**.



**Protect Access to Care: The AHA urges Congress to reject reductions to the Medicaid program that would threaten health care access for patients.**
