Medicaid supports access to essential obstetrics care, behavioral health services, and primary care



Medicaid provides access to care for low-income seniors

21% of births in New Hampshire are covered by Medicaid

42K seniors in New Hampshire are dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid

Fact: Medicaid chronically underpays for services. Without supplemental payments, Medicaid fee-for-services payments nationally paid 58 cents for every dollar that hospitals spent caring for Medicaid patients, and Medicaid managed care organizations paid 65 cents.



<u>Protect Access to Care:</u> The AHA urges Congress to reject reductions to the Medicaid program that would threaten health care access for patients.
